Enactment of new sanctions legislation for the United Kingdom's Overseas Territories¹ (as applicable to the British Virgin Islands, the Cayman Islands and Anguilla)

Following the exit of the United Kingdom from the European Union there has been an enactment of a suite of sanctions legislation that applies in the British Overseas Territories. We have summarised these new pieces of legislation below along with useful links to access the various legislation. All persons engaged in financial services sector should familiarise themselves with these new pieces of legislation and should the situation arise where a relevant entity is dealing with a sanctioned entity or individual as a part of its relevant business then the necessary steps should be taken to liaise with legal counsel and the relevant local competent authority with responsibility for the sanctions regime.
